



Call For Papers for 2026 Southwestern Finance Association Doctoral Consortium

The Southwestern Finance Association will host a Doctoral Student Consortium on **Wednesday, March 25, 2026, from 10:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.**, as part of the 65th Annual Southwestern Finance Conference at the Hyatt Regency Dallas in Dallas, Texas. Doctoral students who have submitted their papers to the 2026 SWFA Conference are invited to participate in the consortium.

Coordinated by Dr. Renee Adebile, Associate Professor of Finance at the University of Wisconsin- Parkside, the Doctoral Student Consortium provides an opportunity for participants to present job market papers or dissertation proposals and receive feedback from distinguished faculty. Selected participants will receive a Doctoral Student Consortium award that covers conference registration.

Notification of selection will be sent by February 14, 2026.

Requirements

- Job market paper or working paper submitted to the SWFA 2026 conference.
- Students expressed interest in participating in the consortium during registration.
- Students will be on the job market in the 2026-27 academic year.

Selection Criteria

- Quality, originality, and clarity of the submitted paper
- Relevance to academic finance
- Diversity in institutional representation and research topics
- Alignment with available faculty expertise for discussant assignments
